## Lt. Commander Sean D. Krueger Waterboro

Sean Krueger was born in New Haven, CT on September 24, 1976 to David and Maura (Doyle) Krueger. He graduated from Massabesic High School in Waterboro, ME in 1994 and enlisted in the USCG. Upon completion of basic training in Cape May, NJ Sean was stationed aboard the CGC Bittersweet in Woods Hole, MA. He later earned an appointment to the USCG Academy in New London, CT and graduated in May of 2000. During his first tour aboard the CGC Sundew in Duluth MN, he married the former Kyla Trimby of Laconia, NH and was blessed with their first son Trevor. Sean was selected for and graduated from the Naval Flight School in Pensacola, FL and was assigned as an MH-60 Jayhawk pilot in Cape Cod, MA where their first daughter, Kerryann was born. Sean was subsequently selected for an exchange tour with the Royal Navy, flying the H-3 Sea King at RNAS Culdrose, in Helston, Cornwall, England.
